# Ickenham Festival Team

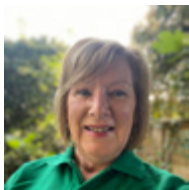

# In Memorial



**DAVID ARTHUR MILLEN**  
24<sup>TH</sup> JULY 1934 TO

Last year we were sad to hear of the passing of our President and Founder. It was David, who whilst attending a party in Ickenham in the early 1970s, started a discussion about the many groups and societies that operate within our village. This discussion fell on fertile ground and it was agreed to set up a meeting with the leaders of as many of these groups as could be identified.

After a successful meeting a committee was formed with David at its head, to push forward with the vision of staging a Festival where these groups, societies and associations could showcase their talents and interests to the rest of The Village.

That first Festival was centred around the green space of Community Close, but the following year permission was obtained to hold a Royal Silver Jubilee Festival in The Swakeleys House Grounds.

It was decided, going forward, to hold it on a biannual basis. 2026 will therefore be your Golden Jubilee, but not your 50th Ickenham Festival.

David stepped back from The Festival some time ago to become Church Warden at St Giles, but not before he was sure that the future of The Festival was in safe hands for a few more years.
